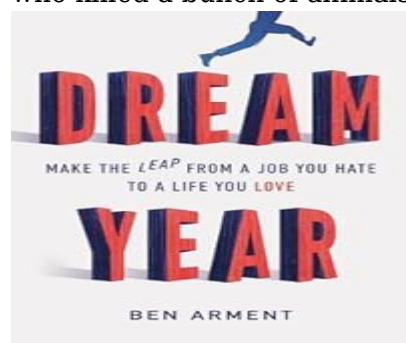


Dreamyard prep
